## Policy: Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19)

The health and safety of our clients, volunteers and those we work with is our highest priority. To ensure that our clients and volunteer drivers are protected to the best of our/their ability during the current Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, we have provided a 'go bag' for our drivers with essential sanitizing and personal protective items, including:

Exam gloves (non-latex)	Tissues	Face masks
Hand Sanitizer	Sanitizing wipes	Spray sanitizer

During this COVID-19 pandemic, it is recommended that each driver use sanitizer wipes to wipe down all frequently touched areas, including the steering wheel, dashboard, arm rests, door knobs/handles (inside and out), door jams, countertops, wheelchair and walker handles and arm rests.

Because of the current COVID-19 the Volunteer Center will not be able to transport clients until further notice. In the meantime, we are eager to continue serving our neighbors. We might assist with delivering a good book from the library or picking up grocery orders from local Calaveras County grocery stores.

In these dangerous and challenging times, clients will need to reschedule appointments for at least two months later, at which time we will re-evaluate our transportation options with guidance from Public Health officials. If their appointment is of a critical or urgent nature, we will advise them to call their physician for guidance.

**In an emergency, they will be advised to call 911.**

The Volunteer Center was established in the early 1980s as a resource to fill unmet needs in our county with special focus on seniors, persons with disabilities, low-income, all ages and all races.
